#### **Instructions for Applicant**

Please submit with your application:

**1.)** Two (2) printed or electronically signed letters of recommendation from people who are not: employed by you, members of your immediate family, or individuals who might be concerned about their relationship with you by speaking honestly. Also excluded are your TCF teachers.

Letter writers should tell how long they have known you and in what capacity, such as fellow volunteer, clergy, etc.

Each letter should describe your character in terms of the writer's interactions with you, citing specific examples.

You are also encouraged to ask one of your current or recent tai chi teachers to provide a verbal recommendation to us based on your participation in class.

- **2.)** One small passport-sized photo of your face with a current likeness.
- **3.**) One, non-refundable application fee of a US\$50 by check or money order, made payable to the Tai Chi Foundation.

The person receiving your application will be able to tell you approximately when you will be notified of the Admissions Committee's decision.

If you're not accepted, you're entitled to an explanation of the rationale and any suggested areas to work on for future improvement and growth, with an eye to possible re-application.

If you're accepted, you'll need to fill out training registration papers separate from this B1 Apprenticeship Application.

Your mentor or the training coordinator can also tell you about any other classes for which you may register and provide your daily training schedule and any registration deadlines.

Ask for advice on arrangements, such as travel or lodging reservations, possible scholarship or workstudy requests, packing suggestions, tai chi preparation beforehand, etc.
